Motions	<u>Virtual</u> , unless otherwise directed by the judge	Examples: Contempt, Disclosure, removal of Counsel from a case, travel with child (International or National), procedural.
Summary Judgment Motions, Trials, Focused Hearings, Arguments on Motions to Change, Substantive Motions, Restraining Orders	<u>In person</u> , unless otherwise directed by the Judge	
Trials	<u>In-person</u> with discretion for witnesses to appear virtually, unless otherwise directed by the judge

CYFSA Proceedings: Temporary Care and Custody hearings	<u>Virtual</u> - unless otherwise directed by the Judge	Efforts should continue to limit the number of participants attending at the courthouse for any in-person appearances
